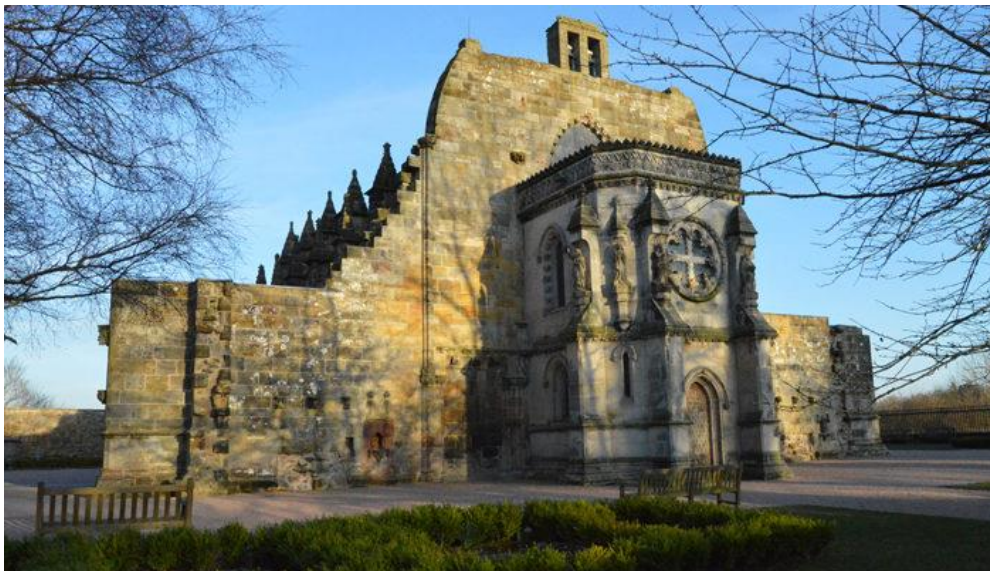


Visit Dan Brown's iconic Da Vinci Code location,

ROSSLYN CHAPEL was founded in 1446 as a place of worship. With its impressive architecture, both inside and out, the Chapel has been a popular destination for visitors for generations. By the late 18th-century, it was starting to appear on itineraries, but it was Dan Brown's novel, *The Da Vinci Code*, in 2003, and the subsequent film that put Rosslyn Chapel on everyone's must see list.
